| Session Types         | Length     | Number of<br>Presenters | Session Format   |
|-----------------------|------------|-------------------------|--|
| Roundtable Discussion | 75 minutes | 2-3                     | Moderated roundtable format with minimal presentation slides; robust dialog between speakers and audience                |
| Panel Presentation    | 75 minutes | 2-3                     | Panel to provide 60 minutes of presentation (20-30 minutes per speaker), followed by at least 15 minutes of audience Q&A |

## **Abstract Rules**

- All abstracts should include 2-3 speakers. At least one of these speakers must be from an Academic Medical Center
  or other healthcare delivery organization.
- Abstracts must include the names, bios and contact information for all speakers.
- Vendors are invited to submit abstracts, but presentations should be free of commercial bias and should not contain marketing materials.
- You will be notified by February 28, 2018 if your abstract was selected.
- Note: If your abstract is selected and it becomes necessary to substitute a speaker, conference organizers must be notified in advance of event and the substitution is subject to approval.
